Teaching staff have worked hard over the holidays to prepare exciting and engaging learning programmes for term four. 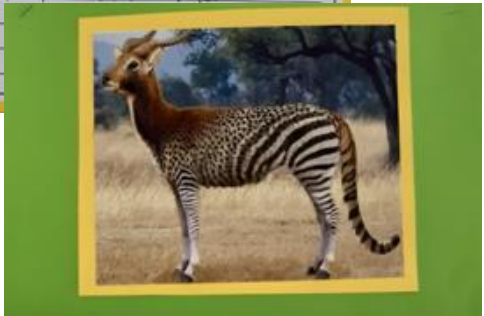
Last term, R10 (Yr 1 & 2) had lots of fun creating our own hybrid animal.
